# THE FUTURE STATE OF PSYCHIATRIC HEALTHCARE

Advanced practice professionals (APPs) are essential in addressing the <u>increasing need</u> for mental health services

- >150 million people live in areas with a shortage of mental health professionals<sup>1</sup>
- 0.2% change in the number of psychiatrists 2016-2021<sup>2</sup>
  - 62% are age 55 or older<sup>3</sup>

## THE VOICE OF ADVANCED PRACTICE PROFESSIONALS

#### BY THE NUMBERS

- Certified physician assistants (PAs) change between 2017 2021: 29%<sup>1</sup>
- PAs specialized in psychiatry: 2%<sup>1</sup>
- Number of licensed nurse practitioners (NPs): **385,000**<sup>2</sup>
- Number of new NPs that completed programs in 2020 2021: >36,000³
- Average number of prescriptions written by NPs each day: 21<sup>4</sup>
